## e-learning

### Care Certificate

It is the responsibility of employers in the health and social care sector to deliver the Care Certificate as part of their staff induction programme. This e-learning course is the ideal resource to deliver the knowledge required in order to achieve the full Care Certificate. The unique e-learning Management System gives the ability to monitor, manage and record training activity.

#### Who should take this course?

Anyone starting work in the health or social care sector should complete the certificate including health care assistants, assistant practitioners, care support workers, adult social care workers providing direct care in residential and nursing homes and hospices; and home care workers.

#### What do learners achieve?

This e-learning programme is flexible so that each learner can complete the standards that are specific to their role. It is also mapped to units on the Qualification and Credit Framework (QCF) relating to health and social care qualifications, meaning learners can use the standards they have completed as recognised prior learning. Upon completion of the course learners will meet the knowledge requirement of the Care Certificate. Once the competence elements have been observed in the workplace the Care Certificate can then be awarded by the employer.
